

Create a Single Web Page Using Dreamweaver

DEFINE A SITE

Create folders and files for your website to live.

On OneDrive – 2 Points

1. Download the ABOUT ME zip folder – **1 point**
2. Unzip the folder by double clicking and then Save the folder to your 3rd 9 Weeks folder. - **1 point**

In Dreamweaver – 4 points

1. Define a site using the ABOUT ME folder that you saved to your 3rd 9 Weeks folder
2. Name your site About Me – **1 Point**
3. Define the Local Site Folder as the ABOUT ME folder that you saved to your 3rd 9 weeks folder – **1 Point**
4. Select the Advanced Settings from the left and Choose Local Info
5. Set the Default Images folder: Use the browse out button to select the images folder inside the ABOUT ME folder. – **1 Point**
6. Hit Save and then create
7. Right off you will see that the styles are not loading to the page
8. Go to the html code and check the link path to the styles sheet. You will have to take out the following `../about me page/` - **1 Point**
9. The page should load styles at this point...if not please ask me

ABOUT ME PAGE

Use Dreamweaver to create a single web page

1. **Logo:** Use a personal logo – you may need to adjust the code a little to fit your size logo – **1 Point**
2. **Profile Picture:** personal photo sized at 259 x 259px – Use Adobe Photoshop to resize and optimize your profile pic for the web. The image file size should be no more than 200kb. – **3 Points**
3. **John Doe:** Replace with Your Name – **1 Point**
4. **Really Awesome Web Designer:** Replace with Your title (be creative) – **1 Point**
 - a. **Paragraph Next to Profile Pic:** Use this section to write a paragraph about yourself that distinguishes you from everyone else. This is the place to tell your story, share your interests and simply tell someone who you are. Don't over think this section and be genuine and honest. Check out this link for some ideas. <http://www.webdesignerdepot.com/2013/04/how-to-create-a-great-about-page/> - **1 Point**
5. **Social Media Icons:** Use **ALL FOUR** circles images to link to your social accounts or at least the basic home page of the social media company. Use Flaticon's website to get social media icons - <http://www.flaticon.com/> - Make sure you read the license agreement and credit the author appropriately in the footer section. When saving icons to your library use the SVG version of the icon if offered. – **4 Points**
6. **Content Holder 1:** Rename this **Contact Information** – **1 Point**

- a. Email – **1 point**
 - b. website (make it up) – **1 Point**
 - c. phone – **1 Point**
 - d. address – **1 Point**
- 7. Content Holder 2:** You have two Options: Rename this section Experience or Volunteer – **2 Points**
- a. Highlight two items from your resume with your title and company and time frame that you have been there. Then write a short description of what you do.
 - b. You can also use this section to highlight clubs/organizations or something that you feel highlights your resume.
 - c. Do not put everything from your resume.
- 8. Download CV** – Rename to “Download Resume” This button will link to your resume – **2 Points**
- a. Convert your resume to a PDF format. To do this: Open in Word and then file Save As, in the format section choose PDF. Save it to your website folder
- 9. BEHANCE** – This is a button to an online portfolio site. If you have an online portfolio use this button to link to the website. If you do not have an online portfolio, you may think about something else you would like someone to access by clicking on this button. It may be a link to a project. **1 - Point**
- 10. GITHUB** – This is a button to an online software site. Again, use this button as a way to link to something that you are interested in and you want others to know. **1 - Point**
- 11. Footer Section** – Contains the copyright information. Update this section with your content and updated dates. Also add the credits for the downloaded icons. – **7 Points**
- 12. Edit/Change styles to give color to the following styles: - 5 Points**
- a. header .profileHeader h1
 - b. .section1 .sectionTitle, .section2 .sectionTitle (this is an h2 style)
 - c. .section2 .sectionContentTitle
 - d. .mainContent .externalResourcesNav .externalResources:hover
 - e. .mainContent .externalResourcesNav .externalResources

- 14.** Preview and Test in the Browser
